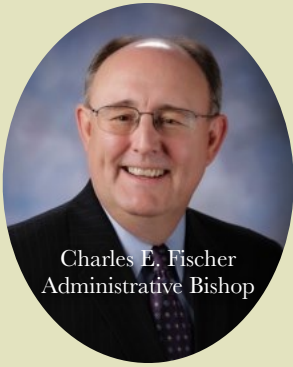

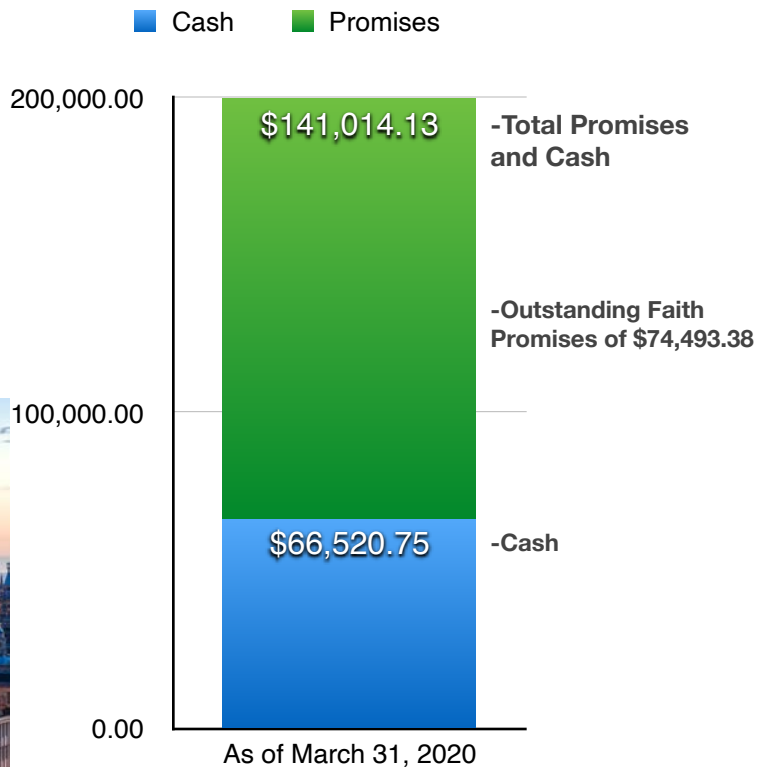

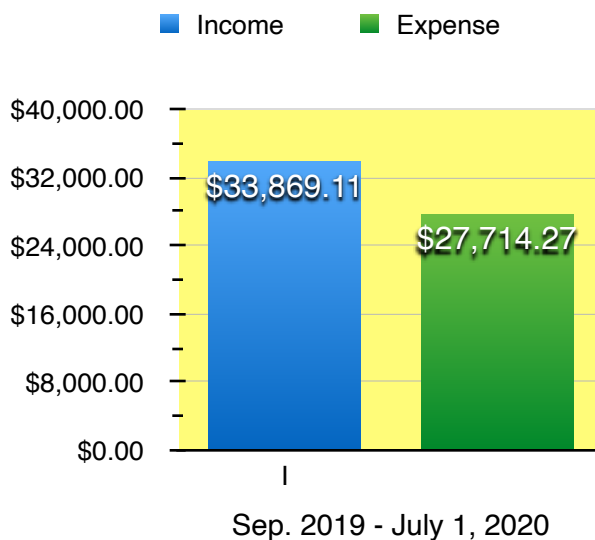

- ◆ We're all praying for an end to COVID 19.
- ◆ Please be sensitive to what God is saying to the church during the pandemic and the recent civil unrest regarding racial diversity and equality issues.



- ◆ Oneida, Laurel Creek Worship Center fed 520 families in April out of their food pantry.
- ◆ Pastor Jason Crum of the Cattlettsburg, Vineyard Church of God had his company making surgical masks and donating them during the COVID 19 crisis.
- ◆ Pastors all over the state have been staying in touch with their members during the pandemic via emails, mail, phone calls, etc.
- ◆ The State Overseer has called every pastor to check on them and their churches. Some could not be reached or were left a message.



- ◆ Wurtland paid off over \$600,000.00 in debt in the last 34 months. A note burning was celebrated on June 21, 2020.
- ◆ We have recently graduated 8 MIP and 6 CAMS students.
- ◆ Kentucky and Indiana will be partnering to bring Leader Labs 2.0 back to Lexington in early 2021.



- ◆ The Well Church plant, under the leadership of Pastor Paul Woosley, is set to launch on August 9, 2020. A launch team of about 25 people have been praying and preparing over the last three months.
- ◆ Many churches are reporting salvations via their online services they started due to COVID 19.
- ◆ Closplint, Corbin, Eastside, Vanceburg, Cynthiana, Webster Ave., Evarts, Harlan, Sunshine and Lexington, River of Life are just a few of the churches who had drive in services the last few months. All had great results.

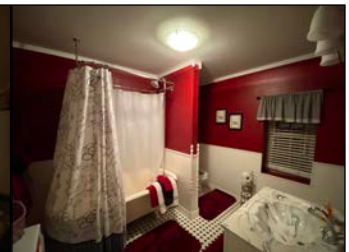
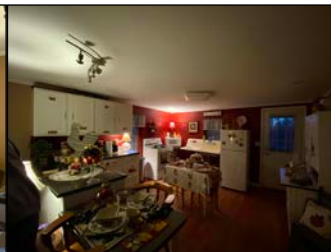
Pikeville Oasis was organized on June 7, 2020 with 32 members. Attendance is running 50+

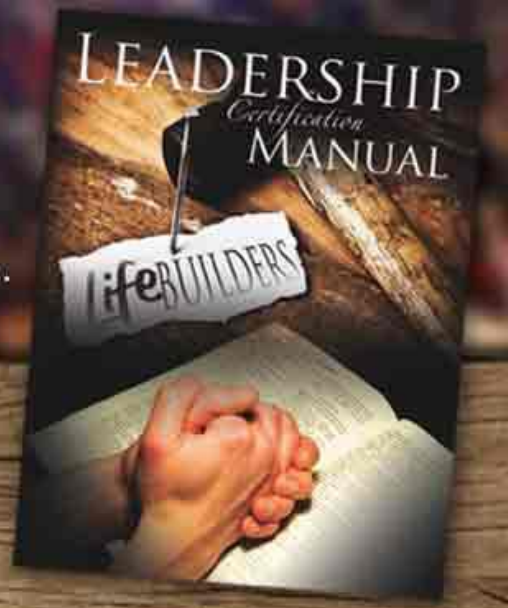

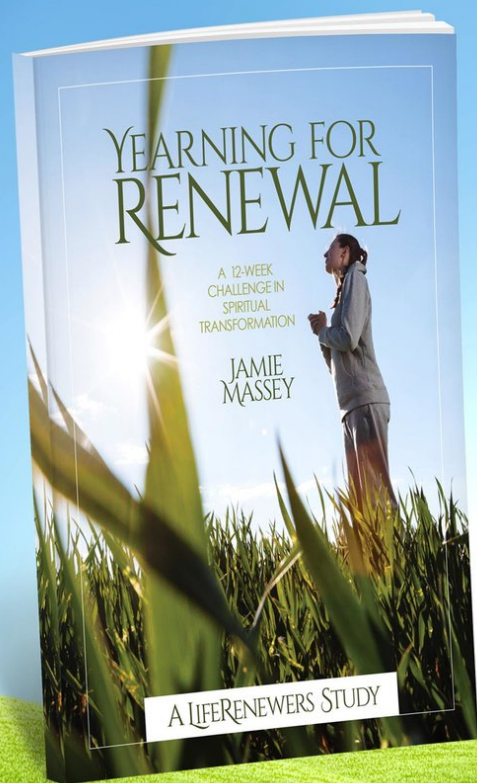

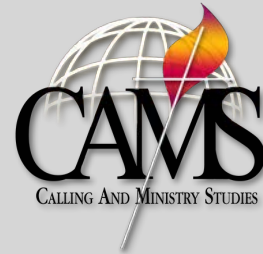
